### Local food supply chains

Short food supply chain can be defined as "short" when it is characterized by short distance or few intermediaries between producers and consumers

Short food supply chains involve very few intermediaries (no more than one – EC, 2013)

SFSCs incorporate dimensions of geographic, social, and economic proximity:

- Geographical proximity: physically close, and is measured as a distance between producers and consumers
- Social proximity: expression is direct (with very few intermediaries) and trustful relations between a
  producer and consumer who know each other and the product, solidarity between producers and
  consumers, civic engagement in local food system, (re)connection with local food traditions and
  identities
- **Economic proximity**: market exchanges happen and money circulates within a community or a certain locality (owned and governed locally, transparent, and traceable)


### Research concept


The aim of this paper is to identify a comprehensive set of good practices leading to growth of SFSCs as one of new forms of farm entrpreneurship.







- Collecting: Wednesday 17.00-19.00 at local coordinator (shop, garage, house) + Chance to taste new products

- Blog keeps attention of the network





#### The future

- Lowest prices compared to existing purchasing groups
- Increasing cooperation and scale of production of farmers, processors and
- Opportunity for small extensive-type farms without certificate (based on trust)
- Economy of scale: effect of Poland
- Prospects for growth and high interest of venture capital (good start-up) plans to grow

#### Results

- Reducing the number of businesses involved in a supply chain between the producer of a raw material and the final customer can **increase the share of the final price** received by farmers.
- Fewer links can also provide cost savings for customers and makes it easier for everyone to know where the raw materials come from
- Economy of scale: effect of Poland (big internal market and demand)
- Increasing cooperation and scale of production of farmers, processors and craftmans
- New forms of economic activities by farmers (transfer of knowledge and technical adjustement to the demand) – increase of farm incomes (average 20-40%)!
- Opportunity for small extensive-type farms without certificate (based on trust – 70%!)
- Prospects for growth and high interest of venture capital (good start-up) plans to grow

### Discussion

- LFS adopt mainly interstitial and symbiotic strategies with the aim of building **alternative practices and social relations** in the food economies. For this reason, local food movements have attracted critiques of being functional to a neoliberal politics of discarding the State (Guthman 2007, Fonte 2015)
- local food initiatives are creating new, enlarged spaces for non-capitalist or post-capitalist economies that
  - pre-figure how the global food system could be transformed in the direction of sustainability, empowerment and social justice
  - may constitute the basis of learning and experimentation necessary to go in that direction
- A new model of governance? A real sustainable economy good direction for future research based on transnational cooperation
